DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This first petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.124 dated 08.06.2021 registered under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Nuh, District Nuh (Haryana).

Reply by way of an affidavit of Usha, HPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Nuh on behalf of respondent No.1 and same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Yash Pal,

does not dispute that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 12.10.2022 staying the arrest of hte petitioner and the order dated 21.12.2022 directing the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
