Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR
No.115 dated 27.5.2022 registered under Sections 323, 379-B, 452, 427,
148, 149, IPC at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

As per the allegations recorded in the FIR, at the time of
occurrence, the petitioner and his companions trespassed into the shop of the
complainant and ransacked the same and co-accused Amanpreet Singh took
away the licensed pistol of the complainant and his co-accused Sandeep
Singh and petitioner Ajay snatched ₹60,000/- from the pocket of the trouser

of the complainant. As has been apprised by the State counsel, the licensed pistol later on recovered from co-accused Sukhdev Singh father of Amanpreet Singh.

Today the counsel for the petitioner informed the Court that petitioner has deposited Rs.20,000/- with the Court concerned and receipt produced by the counsel for the petitioner is ordered to be taken on record. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that after completion of investigation police has presented the challan and that the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 7.10.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
