The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.129 dated 30.05.2016 registered under Sections 420, 466, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 12 of the Passports Act, 1967 at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 11.10.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.10.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
