1. On 06.09.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0044 dated 04.07.2023 registered under Sections 307, 353, 186, 341, 506, 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station City Raikot, District, Ludhiana.

FIR was lodged on the statement of ASI Lachhman Singh revealing that co-accused Hardeep Singh is attributed to have given pipe blow on the head of the complainant whereas co-accused Jagdeep Singh is attributed to have hit some sharp edged weapon on the neck of the complainant. Only attribution to the petitioner is to have proclaimed that complainant should not go escape free.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

Adjourned to 23.11.2023.

In the meantime, in case of arrest, the petitioner shall

be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, learned State counsel has filed status report by way of an affidavit of Satyander Kumar, H.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, State Narcotics Unit, Rohtak dated 01.12.2023, which is taken on record and has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 06.09.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
