The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.737 dated 23.09.2022 registered under Sections 409 IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Hansi, District Hansi.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 09.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Vinod Shankar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
