SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, who are extending threats to him.

2. On the asking of the Court, State counsel has sought instructions and filed reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of police, Sohna, District Gurugram, wherein it has been *inter alia* submitted as under:

“3. *That in reply to the contents of para No.3 of the Criminal Writ Petition it is submitted that on the basis of complaint moved by the petitioner a case vide FIR No.262 dated*

25.09.2023 U/S 452, 506, 34 IPC was registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram. Now the case is under investigation. The police will take the proper action in the matter against the accused persons.

3-A That in reply to the contents of para No.3-A of the Criminal Writ Petition it is submitted that the police has already registered the case against the private respondents and now case is under investigation. The I.O. will take the proper action against the accused persons as per rules. In case the petitioner is having any apprehension danger to his life, then the local police is ready to provide proper security to the petitioner for protection of his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.”

3. In view of the above development, the writ petition is disposed of. Petitioner is at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to him in accordance with law.
