Despite granting repeated opportunities, respondent-State has again failed to file reply. The request to grant more time is declined.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65, dated 03.06.2023, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station D-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that as per allegations contained in the FIR, it is Abhi, who along with 10/11 persons fired at Gurpreet Singh, the nephew of the complainant, hitting on his left chest.

Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. No role attributed to the petitioner and it is Abhi who has been attributed the role of firing with pistol at Gurpreet Singh.

The aforesaid contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner could not be refuted by the learned State counsel.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
