The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.158 dated 17.08.2023 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A stats report dated 05.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Manoj Gors, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division City Sangrur, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.09.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
