1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari setting aside the impugned order dated 16.05.2014 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent no.4.
2. On 18.11.2022, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-
