By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.643 dated 20.12.2021 registered under Sections 120B, 406, 420 IPC at Police Station, Ambala Cantt. District Ambala.

Vide order dated 12.10.2022, petitioner was directed to join the investigation. On 23.03.2023, it was informed on behalf of the petitioner that he was ready to make the payment as per the compromise, which had been earlier effected between the parties and request for short adjournment was made. Matter was then adjourned. On 27.04.2023, petitioner sought time to place on record two post dated cheques for total amount of ₹5,20,000/- to show his bonafides. In the circumstances, interim order was directed to continue.

On 25.07.2023, following order was passed by this Court:-

“An amount of ₹1,30,000/- has been paid on behalf of the petitioner in cash, which has been accepted by complainant Rohit Chauhan, who is present in person.

Counsel for the petitioner has also handed over a cheque bearing No.030130, dated 15.09.2023 for an amount of ₹3,70,000/-, assuring that it will be encashed. It is contended that ₹20,000/- will be paid in cash on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 25.09.2023.

Interim order to continue.”

Today, it is informed by learned counsel for the complainant that cheque for ₹3,70,000/- as given by the petitioner on the last date of hearing has neither been honored, nor the amount of ₹20,000/- has been given in cash.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances, present petition stands dismissed.
