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SANJIV BERRY, J.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar Yadav, Advocate has put in appearance and filed Vakalatnama on behalf of the respondent. The same is taken on record.

2. Arguments heard.

3. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of matrimonial dispute between the parties, multiple cases are pending between the parties out of which 3 cases are pending before the Family Court, Rewari whereas one divorce petition titled as 'Satya Parkas Vs. Shweta' under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act filed by respondent is pending adjudication in the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Camp Court at Kosli. He submitted that the petitioner had moved an application before the Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, to transfer the aforesaid divorce petition from Kosli to Rewari but the same has been declined. The petitioner is having no source of income nor is their any direct

public transport from her village to Kosli, hence he submitted that the divorce petition pending in Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Camp Court at Kosli be transferred to the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, where other 3 cases between the parties are pending.

4. Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent has admitted the fact of the aforesaid litigation's being pending between the parties and hence, categorically and fairly pleaded no objection in case the divorce petition titled 'Satya Parkas Vs. Shweta' under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending in the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Camp Court at Kosli be transferred to the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari.

5. Taking into account the categorical submissions of learned counsel for the respondent and the facts and circumstances the petition bearing No. DMC-267-2021 titled as Satya Parkas Vs. Shweta, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending for 31.07.2023 is hereby ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, Camp Court at Kosli and transferred henceforth to the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari for disposal in accordance with law. The parties through learned counsels are directed to appear before the transferee Court on the date fixed.

6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
