The present petition has been filed with a prayer that by the Resolution dated 13.03.2023 (Annexure P-2), the services of the petitioner is being terminated so as to appoint another person, namely, Surjeet Singh S/o Madan, on the same terms and conditions which is not permissible.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Resolution passed by the Gram Panchayat (Nalvi Kalan), Block Kunjpura, District Karnal is pending consideration with the respondent-State and the petitioner has already filed an application for setting aside the said Resolution which is contrary to the settled principle of law, but no action is being taken by the Government so far.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the application filed by the petitioner, which is pending before the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, if received and not already decided, will be decided within a period of 04 weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
