The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions in the nature of habeas corpus to search the alleged *deneue* Pooja, who has been illegally detained by resonants No. 4 to 9. Today, the alleged *detenue* Pooja has been produced in the Court by ASI Sushila, Police Station Ellenabad.

I have interacted with Pooja, alleged *detenue* and she submits that at present she is residing at Ellenabad with her parents but she wants to join the company of the petitioner. She submits that she is aged about 21 years and is a graduate. Consequently, the alleged *detenue* Pooja is permitted to live at the place of her choice and may accompany the petitioner, if she so desires.

Since the alleged *detenue* Pooja expressed her desire to go with the petitioner, no further orders are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
