The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0148 dated 22.07.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 of IPC and Section 326 of IPC added later on vide DDR No.054 dated 05.08.2023 and Sections 452, 427 of IPC added later on vide DDR No.42 dated 22.08.2023, registered at P.S. Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 05.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Goverdhan Singh, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.
