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**DEEPAK GUPTA J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No. 130 dated 18.05.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 34 of IPC (Sections 452, 148, 149, 188, 269, 271 of IPC deleted later on) at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 31.08.2023 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 06.09.2023 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has

submitted report dated 18.11.2023 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties is genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No. 130 dated 18.05.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 34 of IPC (Sections 452, 148, 149, 188, 269, 271 of IPC deleted later on) at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioner(s), are hereby quashed.
