LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife, challenging judgment and decree dated 16.05.2018, passed by learned District Judge, Family Court, Moga, whereby petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1956, filed by the respondent-husband was allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Appellant has received an amount of ₹8,00,0000/- as full and final settlement of all her claims - past, present and future including permanent alimony, maintenance etc. as well as for her daughter, namely, Avnish Kaur. Statement of the appellant in this regard was recorded before the learned Family Court, Moga on 16.09.2022 and 22.12.2022. In view of the settlement, appellant seeks to withdraw this appeal. Photocopy of affidavit dated 22.12.2022 of the appellant, furnished in Court today in this respect, is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

- 3. Learned counsel for the respondent has affirmed and verified the factum of settlement between the parties.
- 4. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.
- 5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
