DEEPAK MANCHANDA, J.(ORAL)

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Senior Assistant from the department of Local Government, Punjab submits that the petitioner has concealed the material facts from this Court and even did not bring the fact of his joining while passing of the order dated 11.09.2023 whereby operation of the order dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) was stayed by this Court, whereas as per instructions, the petitioner had already joined on 08.09.2023 at the place of posting i.e. Jalalabad in pursuance to the said transfer order.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner states that on 11.09.2023 i.e. on the last date of hearing, the aforesaid fact regarding joining of the petitioner at Jalalabad was not brought into his notice and he argued only on the instructions of his client i.e. petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the parties and since the petitioner has concealed the fact of joining on 08.09.2023 and obtained stay order dated 11.09.2023 by misleading this

Court, the present petition is dismissed with costs and the petitioner is directed to deposit Rs.15,000/- as costs to be deposited with the Institute of Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh and furnish its receipt with the Registry within a period of one month, failing which this petition shall be automatically revived and listed by the Registry and petitioner shall remain present in person with his explanation for non-deposit of costs, as aforesaid.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
