The Counsel for the petitioner contends that as the petitioner nos.1,2 & 4 have appeared before the Trial Court and while pleading guilty have deposited the fine imposed upon them by the Trial Court, therefore, the present petition qua petitioner nos.1, 2 & 4 has been rendered infructuous.

As regards petitioner no.3, as he has not appeared before the Trial Court and has been declared a proclaimed offender, the Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition qua petitioner no.3.

In view of the above, the petition is rendered infructuous qua petitioner nos.1,2 & 4 whereas qua petitioner no.3 the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
