Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 18.10.2021
(Annexure P-18) issued by Tehsildar, Rohtak pursuant to order dated
31.01.2020 passed by District Magistrate, Rohtak.

2. During the course of arguments, it is brought to our notice that
consensus has been arrived at between the parties. A sum of Rs.17.78 lakhs is
stated to be due from the petitioners as on today.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents-Bank on instructions from
Ms. Samandeep Kaur, Manager (Legal), Axis Bank informs that in case, the
said amount is deposited within one week from today, both the accounts of the

petitioners would be settled and closed and No Dues Certificate would be issued to the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has instructions to the effect that the amount in question would be deposited within 15 days along with an interest which may have accrued after the expiry of 07 days from today. The same is stated to be acceptable to respondent-Bank.

5. No further action would be taken by any of the parties in respect to the proceedings in question.

6. In view of the consensus which has been arrived at, this writ petition is disposed of as infructuous without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter.

7. Needless to say, the parties would remain bound by the consensus arrived at between them.
