1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the petitioner competed in pursuance to the Advertisement No. 4/2018 (Annexure P-1) for appointment to Group-D post and had also attached the Orphans Certificate along with the application so as to claim the benefit of 05 marks under the Socio Economic Criteria, which benefit has not been extended to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case the benefit of 05 marks under the Socio Economic Criteria is extended to the petitioner, the petitioner will be in the waiting list of the selected candidates, hence, the petitioner is prejudiced keeping in view the action of the respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 07.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) but the same is still pending consideration with the

respondent and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondent to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-Commission and submits that in case, the representation dated 07.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
