The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65 dated 03.06.2022 registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib (offence under Section 302 IPC was deleted and Section 306 IPC was added later on vide GO No.13 dated 11.09.2022).

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Ranjit, submits that in pursuance of order dated 17.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.01.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
