SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 99, dated 28.02.2021 registered under Sections 398 and 401 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 379, 411 of IPC were added later on) at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

2. After addressing arguments for some time and having faced adverse observations, counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition. However, by placing on record a *Xerox* copy of the invitation card, she submits that petitioner's sister is getting married on 20.12.2023 and the petitioner may be given interim bail to participate in the marriage ceremonies.

3. *Xerox* copy of the invitation card has been given to learned State counsel. He does not have any instructions in this regard. However, noticing that probably there is substance in the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to verify the factum of wedding and in case the assertion of the counsel is found to be factually correct, petitioner be taken to the venue of marriage on 20.12.2023 in the morning in police custody and be brought back to the jail premises on the same day after the ceremonies are over.
4. Superintendent of the jail concerned is directed to make necessary arrangements in this regard.
