Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned order dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1 vide which the learned Financial Commissioner has set aside the order passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Patiala dated 15.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) and also the well reasoned order passed by the District Collector, Sangrur dated 09.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) by which the present petitioner was appointed as Nambardar of the village Shahpur and the appeal filed by respondent Kuldeep Singh was dismissed. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue as a Nambardar of village Shahpur as per the order passed by the District Collector dated 09.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) and the order of dismissal of appeal of respondent No.4 passed by respondent No.2 and for staying the operation of impugned order dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-5)

passed by the learned Financial Commissioner remanding the case to the District Collector.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the submission made be learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
