JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking quashing of charge-sheet dated 29.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent-bank.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that CWP No. 22458 of 2022 filed by petitioner stands dismissed and he has already filed Writ Petition before Delhi High Court which shows that petitioner has accepted that this Court is not an appropriate Court because of lack of jurisdiction.
3. Civil Writ Petition No. 22458 of 2022 filed by petitioner, on account of lack of territorial jurisdiction, has been dismissed with liberty to approach appropriate Court. The present petition too on account of lack of territorial jurisdiction, is not maintainable before this Court.
4. The present petition is hereby dismissed with liberty to petitioner to approach Competent Court of jurisdiction.
