Although, as the report received from the Mediation Centre, settlement has not been effected between the parties, but learned counsel for the complainant has placed on record the compromise deed dated 20.07.2023, submitting that compromise has been effected between the parties today itself. Learned counsel for the complainant further submits that quashing petition shall be filed shortly. He also submits that he has no objection to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid statement, petitioner is admitted to anticipatory bail in case FIR No.442, dated 26.08.2022, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala, under Sections 420 and 406 of IPC, subject to the condition that he shall join the investigation, if and so required by the Investigation Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Earlier, an amount of ₹75,00,000/- by way of demand draft was deposited with the Registrar General of this Court by the petitioner, as per order dated 18.01.2023. As per the settlement effected between the

parties, copy of which has been placed on record, it is the first party of

the settlement i.e. Harpal Singh-complainant, who will be entitled to receive the said amount of ₹75,00,000/-.

In view of the said settlement, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no objection if the settlement amount of ₹75,00,000/- is released in favour of the complainant.

In view of the above, Registry is directed to release the amount of ₹75,00,000/- to the complainant, namely, Harpal Singh.
