The petitioner is employed through an outsourcing agency as the District Assistant in the District AIDS Prevention and Control Unit. She challenges the recruitment notice issued by the Department for selecting the District Assistant. She apprehends that she would be replaced by another contractual employee.

While defending the writ petition, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has made three attempts to clear the examination held for appointment on the contractual basis, however, she failed. In such circumstances, this Court does not find it appropriate to issue the writ, which may entail continuation of the petitioner.

Hence, dismissed.
