Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the subsequent development during pendency of the petition i.e. passing of moratorium order and passing of the order dated 4th January, 2023 by the executing court, no cause of action survives at this stage for pursuing the present petition.

The relevant portion of the order dated 4th January, 2023 passed by Exclusive Commercial Court, Gurugram is reproduced below:-

“In the light of discussion above, there is no option but to close the proceedings of present execution for the time being while granting liberty to the parties to get the same revived in accordance with law, if needed, at any subsequent stage. I order accordingly.”

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of.
