JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to Taekwondo Federation of India-respondent No.4 to permit the petitioner to join National Taekwondo Championship to be held at Guwahati, Assam w.e.f 09.09.2023 to 11.09.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner Association is affiliated to Taekwondo Federation of India vide affiliation certificate dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-7). The parent body i.e. Taekwondo Federation of India is organizing National Championship at Guwahati, Assam, however, petitioner has not been permitted to participate. The Championship is going to take place from 09.09.2023 to 11.09.2023. The respondent No.4 is permitting those Associations which

are not affiliated with Taekwondo Federation of India, however, petitioner is not permitted to join. In support of his contention, learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 16.02.2017 passed by this Court in ***CWP No.2616 of 2017***.

3. Mr. Ankur Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel who on advance notice is present in Court assures the Court that Association would consider case of the petitioner and by tomorrow an appropriate order would be passed considering representation of the petitioner as well as order dated 16.02.2017 passed by this Court in the aforesaid writ petition.

4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the respondent- UOI, the present petition stands disposed of.
