By way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner is praying for regular bail in case FIR No.104, dated 27.03.2022, registered at Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 483 IPC and Sections 27-A and 29 of the NDPS Act added later on).

Allegations are that from a Scorpio vehicle being driven by petitioner Sarabjeet Singh and which was also occupied by three more persons, namely, Monu, Savita and Amrita, 63 Kg. of ganja i.e. of commercial quantity was recovered on 27.03.2022.

As per the status report filed by Shri Amit Yashwardhan, Addl. Superintendent of Police, Badli, District Jhajjar, petitioner is in custody ever since then i.e. for the period of more than 10 months. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Though challan has already been filed, but no witness has been examined so far.

Having regard to the aforesaid circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
