Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.182 dated 08.10.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

It is contended by learned counsel that petitioner was on bail in this case. He was regularly appearing before the Trial Court. However, on 09.05.2023, he could not appear due to certain circumstances beyond his control, due to which his bail was cancelled vide order dated 09.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) and warrants of arrest were directed to be issued. Learned counsel contends that earlier petitioner filed a petition bearing No.CRM-M-38396-2023 challenging the order whereby his bail was cancelled but that was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to move the appropriate petition.

Learned counsel further contends that petitioner is ready to surrender before the Trial Court. Next date of hearing is stated to be 06.10.2023.

This petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 06.10.2023. On his such surrender, Trial Court shall initiate appropriate proceedings under Section 446

Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and after disposal of those proceedings, petitioner shall be admitted to bail. Till the disposal of those proceedings, petitioner shall not be taken into custody.

If in the meantime, due to warrants of arrest having been issued against the petitioner, he is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
