The petitioners have filed the present petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and also to ensure that they are not implicated in some false case as respondent No.4 was threatening them with dire consequences.

Notice was issued to the respondents and in response thereto, status report by way of affidavit of ACP, West, Jalandhar has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that FIR No.149, dated 26.08.2021 under Sections 354, 354C, 354D, 120B and 212 of IPC and Sections-66D, 66E, 67A of IT Act, 2000, Police Station Division No.5 has been registered on the basis of statement made by the complainant Anju daughter of Ram Kishan, against Ajay Kumar son of petitioners No.1 and 2. He further submits that after registration of the FIR, during investigation, it was found that the fake instagram ID was created in the name of Sahil Mahey, who was arrested on 29<sup>th</sup>

January 2022. During investigation, Sahil Mahey made a disclosure statement that Ajay Kumar son of Amarjit (petitioner No.1) was living in his house after registration of the FIR and used to operate instagram ID from his mobile phone and Amarjit Singh, petitioner No.1 had left Ajay Kumar at Delhi airport to send him abroad.

On this DDR No.26 dated 29<sup>th</sup> January,2022 was recorded and the offence under sections 212, 120B was added. He further submits that the petitioner No.1 is directly involved in harboring and aiding the main accused, which was evident from the disclosure statement made by Sahil Mahey.

As a result, petitioner No.1 was arrested and has been granted the concession of bail.

Learned State counsel has further assured the Court that the investigation shall be conducted in accordance with law.

In view of the above submissions, no further orders are required and the instant petition is disposed of as such.
