SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Lovejot Kaur and Gurlal Singh, petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be of marriageable age. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5. They apprehend danger from them and seek protection to their life and liberty. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate, Annexure P3, and marriage photographs, Annexure P4, evidencing their marriage. Petitioner No.1 claims to have submitted a representation dated 31.08.2023 (Annexure P5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran - respondent No.2.

2. During the pendency of the petition, a status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3, wherein it has been submitted that the statements of the relatives of the petitioners have been recorded and they do not have any objection to the marriage of the petitioners. It

has been further submitted that in case the petitioners have any threat perception from the private respondents, they are at liberty to approach the local police for protection.

3. In view of the status report, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
