The challenge in the present appeal is to the order dated 28.07.2023 whereby the anticipatory bail of the petitioner was declined in FIR No.0206 dated 18.05.2023 under Sections 147, 149, 294, 323, 506 IPC (Section 308 added later on), Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at P.S. Agroha, District Hisar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 06.09.2023 passed by this Court, appellant has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Additonal Superintendent of Police, Hisar in

Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions from ASI Ramjit Lal submits that the appellant has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 06.09.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 06.09.2023 is made absolute.

However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Appeal stands disposed of.
