SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

Order dated 28.10.2022 passed by this Court says as under:

“This petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, contains peculiar facts and circumstances, inasmuch as, a daughter (petitioner), who is aged about 24 years and working with Air India as its crew member, is seeking protection from her own father, mother and maternal uncle (respondent Nos. 4, 5 and 6, respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though closely related, but all the private respondents have created havoc by their behaviour in the life of the petitioner. Therefore, she is apprehensive of any untoward incident that may happen with her at the instance of private respondents.

Without going into veracity of the allegations levelled in the present petition, this Court would like to seek status report in the matter.

Accordingly, Mr. J.S. Arora, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, is directed to seek instructions/ clarification from concerned police officer and to file a status report in regard to apprehension raised by petitioner in the present petition.

Adjourned to 11.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply complete copy of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of day, if already not supplied.”

Thereafter, status report dated 05.12.2022 was filed by learned State counsel and same is already available on the record.

Relevant paragraphs No. 3 and 4 of the said status report says as under:

“3. That accordingly, the Respondents No. 4, 5 and 6 were called in the Police Station and were asked about the allegations leveled by the petitioner against them.

4. That the father of the petitioner namely Rajinderjit Singh and mother Gurdeep Kaur (Respondents No 4 and 5) have categorically stated that their daughter Yashpreet Kaur is aged about 24 years and is doing the job of Air Hostess in the Air Asia. She is residing in Bangalore for the last 3 years. They further stated that they never pressurized their daughter Yashpreet Kaur to get married and she has also not come to meet them for the last 2 years. Their daughter talks to them on phone. They further stated that their daughter is free to reside anywhere she wants and there shall be no interference in her life and she is free to marry whenever and wherever she wants. True Copies of the statement of the Respondents No. 4 and 5 are appended as ANNEXURE R-1 & R-2”.

In view of the stand taken by respondent-State in the said status report, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
