Custody certificate dated 07.01.2023, filed by learned counsel for the State is taken on record.

As per the custody certificate, in the present case, vide judgment of conviction dated 01.12.2022 passed by the trial Court, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 06 months and to pay a fine of Rs.5000/- and in default thereof, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for the period of 15 days. It has also been mentioned in the said custody certificate the petitioner was released from custody on 19.12.2022, after undergoing the sentence awarded to him.
