The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.134 dated 26.08.2020 under Sections 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kharar (P-2) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

The present petition was filed in the year 2022 whereby the notices have been issued to the respondents on 14.10.2022. However, notice could not be issued to respondent No.2 for non-filing of process fee.

Learned counsel was informed about the said factum vide order dated 08.12.2022, however as per office report, again process fee has not been filed due to which notice could not be issued to respondent No.2.

Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
