[1] This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3, i.e. the Assistant Inspector General of Police (AIG), NRI Wing, Patiala and the Station House Officer, NRI Wing, Sangrur, respectively, to take fair, impartial and proper action on the complaint/representation dated 11.02.2023 (Annexure P-6), in view of the law laid down by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Lalita Kumar vs. Government of U.P. And others** 2014 (1) SCC (CrI.) 525.

[2] Learned counsel for the State submits that the proceedings in the said representation dated 11.02.2023 (Annexure P-6) have already been concluded and a decision has been taken to close the matter since part of the alleged occurrence took place in Canada. The report of the concerned NRI Wing has been accepted by the Additional Director General of Police (NRI Wings).

[3] The State counsel further submitted that a written intimation shall be given to the petitioner within a period of 07 days.

[4] Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his appropriate remedy, as per law.

[5] Ordered accordingly.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
