1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
222	14.10.2018	Tripuri, District Patiala	302 and 34, IPC

2. At the outset and in all fairness, upon instructions, learned senior counsel submits that the petitioner, who is abroad, is prepared to surrender before the Court and join the proceedings. He submits that he does not press the prayer made in the petition at this stage, but requests that a direction be issued to the learned Magistrate to decide the prayer for bail, which petitioner intends to make on surrender.

3. Request of the counsel has been considered.

4. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court/Area Magistrate within six weeks from today and moves an application seeking regular bail, Trial Court/Area Magistrate shall decide the application as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one week of its filing.

5. Petition is disposed of.
