1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC seeking exemption from filing the certified copies of Annexures P-1 to P-5.

2. Allowed as prayed for.

This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.12.2022 passed in CWP-28190-2022.

4. Counsel for the State has produced copy of order dated 13.12.2023 to show that pursuant to the order dated 08.12.2022, the respondent has now decided the legal notice and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
