The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 24.4.2022 registered under sections 22(c), 21(b) of NDPS Act at Police Station, City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since 24.4.2022 and the trial is not progressing and as such the petitioner is entitled to be released on bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Maninder Singh submits that only challan has been presented in this case and the recovery effected from the petitioner contains 1000 grams of Tramadol narcotic salt which is a highly commercial quantity.

In view of the above position, no ground for granting regular bail to the petitioner is made out. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed, at this stage.
