JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petitioner under Section 482 of Cr.PC. is seeking direction to official respondents to take appropriate action against in FIR No.0076 dated 26.06.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 354, 295, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned State counsel at the outset submits that police after completing investigation has found no substance in the complaint and accordingly cancellation report has been prepared. The cancellation report has been presented before a senior official and appropriate steps would be taken in due course. He further submits that report in either way would be filed within one month from today before the Trial Court.

3. The petitioner has remedy to raise his all pleas before the Trial Court in the form of protest petition as well as to file complaint under Section 190 Cr.P.C. Thus, in view of statement of learned State counsel no further order is warranted.
