Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to enter and sanction the mutation of land purchased by the petitioner in the Court auction for which sale certificate of December 2018 (Annexure P-1) and sale certificate dated 16.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) were issued in favour of the petitioner without payment of stamp duty. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents/Registering Officer to file the copy of sale certificates of December 2018 and sale certificate dated 16.01.2019 in Book No.1 without payment of stamp duty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already served legal notice dated 28.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) upon respondents but no action has been taken in the same till date. He further submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka to look into the legal notice dated 28.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
