1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.243 dated 23.09.2022, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.
2. At the outset, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has submitted on specific instructions that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 27.10.2022, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he is fully cooperating with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submitted that the recovered quantity from the petitioner does not fall in the commercial quantity under the NDPS Act.
3. In view of the stand taken by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.10.2022 is hereby made absolute.
