ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the respondents submits that considering the case of the petitioner to be a special case, the leave granted to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.03.2023 to 20.03.2023, qua which, the salary was deducted, will be considered as Child Care Leave and no salary will be deducted. It is further submitted that the prayer of the petitioner for grant of Child Care Leave w.e.f. 01.10.2023 to 30.11.2023 will be accepted treating it to be an exceptional case, in which, the petitioner is facing great hardship.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case a fresh application is filed by the petitioner seeking grant of Child Care Leave, the same may be considered by the respondents in terms of the order(s) of this Court, to which, learned counsel for the respondents has no objection.

In view of the above undertaking given by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is rendered infructuous, at this stage,

with a right to revive, if so required.

Rule stands discharged.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to pay the requisite fee to learned counsel for the petitioner.
