DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.435 dated 02.12.2021 registered under Sections 452, 326, 148, 149 & 506 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Power of attorney on behalf of complainant-injured Harman Sharma has been filed by Mr. Monty Goyal, Advocate. Same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that matter has been compromised between the parties and quashing petition shall be filed soon.

Learned counsel for complainant-injured admits the factum of compromise and stated that he has no objection if the petitioner is allowed regular bail.

However, learned State counsel opposes the request of bail on the ground that petitioner is involved in three more cases.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel

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reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last one year.

Considering the fact that matter has been compromised between the parties and petitioner is in custody for the last one year, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
