Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to consider and take appropriate action on the representation dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-5).

2. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had got registered an FIR No. 03 dated 02.01.2023, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Mauli Jagran, U.T. Chandigarh. But till date no action has been taken by the police against the accused in the FIR in question despite the fact that anticipatory bail application qua one of the accused has already been dismissed by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Head Quarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh. But no action has been taken on the said representation.

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4. It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) in an expeditious manner.
5. Notice of motion.
6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Abhinav Gupta, Addl. P.P. U.T. Chandigarh, along with SI Malkeet Singh, has put in apperance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.
7. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh Police, Police Headquarters, Sector 9, U.T. Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
9. Disposed of.
