The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.82 dated 23.07.2021 under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Women Police Station, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 06.12.2022 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court and record their statements for quashing of the present FIR on the basis of compromise dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-2).

A perusal of report dated 10.03.2023 received from learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana through learned District & Sessions, Ludhiana reveals that complainant/Respondent No.2 herein, had appeared before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court and stated that “*compromise has not been effected with the accused*”.

Since the respondent has backed out from the compromise dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-2), no further direction is warranted in the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
