1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Joginder Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 22.09.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 22.09.2023 is made absolute subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

4. Noticing that the petitioner is involved in three criminal cases all of which have been registered against him for offences under the NDPS Act, petitioner shall furnish an undertaking by way of an affidavit to the Investigating Officer as well as the Area Magistrate to the effect that henceforth he will not indulge in any unlawful activity. In case, he is found to be involved in any other criminal case, State shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of bail.
