[1] Challenge in the petition is to orders Annexure P-1 and P-2 dated 05.08.2019 and 31.08.2019 respectively passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Tarn Taran allowing the application under Section 24, Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and fixing maintenance of Rs.5,000/- per month, besides, awarding litigation expenses.
