The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0097 dated 21.09.2022 under Sections 323, 427, 341, 365, 511 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sector-3, Chandigarh.

As per the allegations levelled in the FIR in question, the petitioner along with co-accused had come to attend the hearing of a case before the High Court. On seeing the complainant party, all the accused including the petitioner tried to block their way by putting plastic cones on the way. Still further, they tried to grab the hand of one Ravinder Pal Kaur, who was travelling in the car of the complainant, however, the attempt was thwarted by the police officials.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 14.10.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions has not disputed the

submissions made by the counsel opposite. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 14.10.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
